## 6. Director's Report

#### Overview of 2009/2010

Last year enrolment was up to 41 students. Many came into the program late in September, which put some stresses on our registration system.

Reformatting the new parent orientation sessions have allowed for better attendance in the spring by families registering for this upcoming year. This also allows for registrants at any time of the year.

ESFRS had 5 teachers; 5 taught flute and 2 of these also taught recorder

Summer Institute held in Edmonton with flute teacher training offered for the first time in Western Canada was very successful and attended by 5 teachers & 5 students. We expected to have to subsidize this program, but it broke even. Considerations are being made to hold it again next summer rather than every 2 years in order to maintain momentum.

Bookkeeping professionally organized and maintained - thanks, Teresa!

#### Current Year 2010/2011

Enrolment is currently at 35 with 2 pending; 7 beginners, however some long term students have left as they graduated from high school. Some also leave at grade 6, not realizing that the program continues beyond elementary school.

Registration was much smoother with fewer late registrations, enhanced communication and use of e-receipts. Thank you Megan! There is no longer a

drop envelope at the school for ESFRS. All registrations/mailings are to be directed to the box office address.

Currently ESFRS has 4 teachers; 4 teach flute and 2 also teach recorder. One teacher resigned due to family and school demands.
